What's Your Super Power?	The Senses	Children will look at the different senses and how they interact with one another, and what our senses enable us to do. Children will also learn about sound and how sounds are made.
Legs and Tails	Animals	Children will discover different types of animals. From mammals, to birds, to insects, children will see images and video clips which show animals in different habitats around the world, including those that live on a farm.
Long, Long Ago	Health and safety	Children will learn how to be safe - around the home and when using equipment, including how to take precautions and how to react if you are unsafe.
On the Move	Machines	Children begin by learning about non-living things before moving on to learn about machinery and how it makes it easier for humans to complete certain jobs. Within the idea of machinery, children can also think about different types of transport and how we use these.
Ready, Steady, Grow	Plants	Children will explore plants. They will learn about how plants are made, where they come from and how to look after them. They will make a start on thinking about why plants are so important and learn some key vocabulary about different parts of plants.
